Service Members in Schools

WLF will work with schools that support our troops by sending them packages and letters to enable a member of a unit they helped to visit the school and thank them personally. Packages and letters are a tremendous morale boost to all our personnel serving overseas and they greatly enjoy the opportunity to show their gratitude, in addition it gives the children an opportunity to meet members of our military.



Warrior Scholarships

WLF will grant a scholarship to one member of each of the four services annually. These individuals must have served at least one combat tour or have served as a Drill Sergeant or equivalent. They must also agree to attend a state school for the purposes of receiving and using a degree in education. Participants must also agree to serve in a n education role for at least 5 years.

Warrior Retreat Ranch

WLF is building a camp in South Texas where we will host returned warriors and their families for a program that helps them re-connect as a family and as members of our society. We all recognize that returning from war is difficult and that support from family, friends, comrades and the society at large is vital for a successful transition. We will offer counseling, both professional and peer to peer, as well as a wealth of programs to allow the returning vets to ease their way out of battle mode.

Hometown Memorial Project

Any city or town can apply to have WLF help them fundraise and build a monument to their fallen. We will commit to match any funds they raise themselves and also to connect them with artists who have agreed to give favorable pricing on the monuments.
